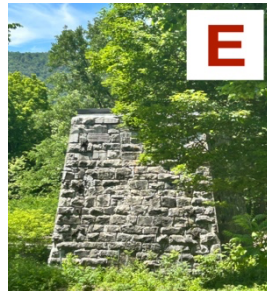


Rallye Route 2026!

Q1-Q6: Look for these 6 landmarks along the route. Put the corresponding letters (A-F) on the answer sheet in the order in which you see them on the route.



1. Make sure the red Rallye placard is in your windshield, set your odometer to 0, and take a left at light leaving New Country BMW.
2. Get in the right lane quickly.
3. Right at 1st right.
4. Left at 1st left onto HOV lane.
5. Take the exit for Route 218, and take a left at the light at the end of the exit ramp.

Q7: This church serves a legendary Thanksgiving potluck.

Q8: Clever name for a canine daycare and grooming service.

6. After you pass a brown barn where you can buy ice cream, count lights and take a left at the 2nd light.
7. After you pass the Pastoral Center/Saint Thomas Seminary, count lights and take a right at the 2nd light then bear right at the stop sign that immediately follows.

Pro tip: Remember to stay on current road unless told to turn.

Q9: Who welcomes members & guests?

Q10: Lots of happenings at the 4-H Farm! Name one.

Q11: Name an item being offered at Wade's Farm Fresh.

Q12: Which observation point has an access road on this stretch?

8. After you pass Folly Farm at the bottom of a long hill, veer right.

Q13: Who is evidently very proud of the Rosedale Farms' sign?

9. Left at 1st left.

Q14: What is the name of the horse farm?

Q15: What has been added to make the Drake Hill Bridge even more beautiful?

10. Left at 1st left.

11. Left at 1st light, followed by immediate right at next light.

Q16: What is the Simsbury High School's athletes' mascot?

12. After passing Homestead Road, take a right at light toward George's Farm.

Q17: An unusual animal crossing sign on this road.

Q18: What is Joshua's favorite bird?

13. Left at T. Enjoy this curvy road!

Q19: One might consider *this* car "out-standing in its field." What color is it?

14. Left at stop sign.

15. Right at stop sign.

16. At stop sign, careful left (onto 20).

Q20: Who invites you to visit their cart?

17. After you pass the Hampstead Hill Club (on right) and mailbox #245 (on left), start counting Chevron signs that point to the right like this, and after the 6th one, take a left.



18. Left at 1st left where stone wall ends. Drive carefully! A few bumps and sharp turns here.

19. Left at T.

20. Stay straight to get on 219 South where 179 veers off to the left.

Q21: Which sign is NOT seen along this stretch?



21. Bear right onto 318W, and make sure the red Rallye placard is in your windshield so Dante, our photographer, can spot you coming!
Be on the look-out for him along this stretch! Slow down and wave!

22. Right at 1st right.

23. Veer left after cemetery and then immediately left again at stop sign.

24. Left at 1st left.

25. Sharp right after brown and white downhill skier sign onto Route 219 South.
Enjoy!

26. Right at 1st light (onto 44).

Q22: What service can you have done at #540?

Q23: Name of this neigh-borhood's favorite restaurant.

Q24: This place took its own advice and *up and went*.

- If you reach this point in the directions and it is BEFORE 11:00 am, carry on with the directions below this box and on the following pages.
- If it is AFTER 11:00 am, use GPS to go directly to Lime Rock Park (44 most of the way) in time for lunch and parade laps.

27. After you pass Ken's Wine & Spirits and a place you can buy a lazy French Bulldog, take a right and stay straight to go up a steep hill.

Q25: How many traditional American flags do you pass before direction #28?

28. Left at stop sign.

29. Right at the stop sign at the Y, away from the dead end.

30. Right at light.

Q26: Where should you bring your dirty car for a “peachy-keen” clean?

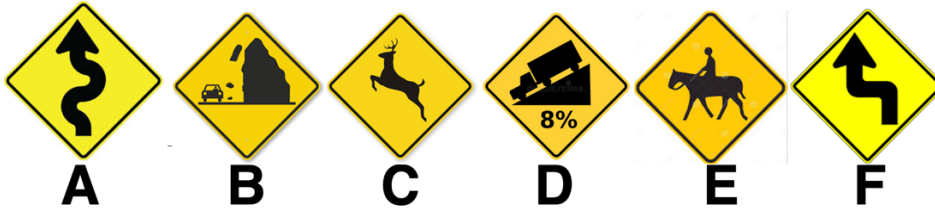
31. Left at 1st light, kitty-korner to a Shell Station.

32. Left at stop sign and then an immediate right.

33. At stop after Colebrook Congregational Church and in front of Colebrook Store, take a left at the stop sign.

34. Right at 1st right.

Q27: Which sign is NOT seen along this stretch?



35. Left at stop sign, followed by immediate right at the next stop sign.

Q28: What school has an inviting playground?

36. After you pass the Norfolk Library, the home of the Chamber Music Festival, and Infinity Hall, veer off of 44 by going straight (don't bear left to stay on Route 44). The World War I Memorial should be on your left.

Q29: The worst place to lose your sewing needle.

37. Left at first 4-way intersection sign 

Please drive cautiously: there are two mild speed humps on this road.

38. Right at T/stop sign.

Q30: What design choice makes the Laurelbrook Farm unique?

Q31: Who makes the farm tables being sold?

Q32: At this “ranch,” you might be able to lasso a Lhasa Apso.

39. After you pass Elm Knoll Farm and a tiny Post Office, take a left in front of the North Canaan Congregational Church sign and the East Canaan Veterans Monument.

Q33: Where can you enjoy some Pinot and then take a nap?

Q34 The workers at this location are sedimental about their jobs.

40. Right at stop sign.

41. Left at light (onto Route 44).

Q35: Who is making pizza at the Roma Pizzeria?

42. Bear left before the Canaan United Methodist Church to stay on Route 44W.

Q36: Jaycox's favorite car, evidently.

43. After you pass Raymond Ave (on right) and a sign that looks like this,



slow down and take the next left (comes up quickly!) and then immediately take another left. If you get to a bridge going over the Housatonic, you went too far!

44. After a 90 degree curve to the left, slow down, and at the bottom of the hill, turn right (at a stop sign) so that you are now driving past the backside of the farm. Enjoy the drive!

45. Left at stop sign.

Q37: One might find the Blarney Stone and a leprechaun on this road.

46. After a "Welcome to Falls Village" sign, yield carefully to the right, bear right to go under a stone railroad bridge, and continue bearing right until a huge stone wall is on your right and a power plant is on your left.

47. Stay on the current road as it curves left and then cross the red bridge (the Housatonic!). Go left as soon as you get off the bridge. Enjoy the ride!

48. Right at the T/stop sign onto Route 112.

**** Please place the Rallye placard AND Track Lap Pass (if applicable) in your windshield!**

49. Left at the bottom of the hill onto White Hollow Road, left at the first left, then left again to enter the park by the Gatehouse. Please make sure the Gatehouse Staff sees your Rallye Placard. Once they wave you in..

- Drive straight through the gates and over the bridge. We will be gathering on the left side of the road as you come off the bridge.
- If you are NOT going on the track, look for someone official to park you BEYOND the track access road.
- If you ARE going on the track, look for someone official to park you BEFORE the track access road.
